“Rooster was the most exciting dog around! She could never sit still. She loved barking at the animals on tv, chasing butterflies, and cleaning our dinner plates each night!

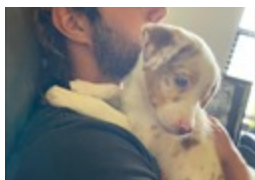
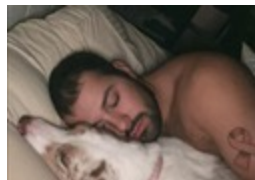
